

## Level 3 Graphic Design Interview Requirements

Please prepare the below for your interview:

1. Minimum of 12 examples of design, these can be a mix of Internet found examples and ones from real-life, not all of them should come from the Internet. This should include examples of ones you think are good and ones you think are bad. They all need to be annotated with notes explaining what they are, what you think of them, what you like and what you don't like, and if you think they are bad ones, how you might improve them.
2. One logo design for yourself, it should reflect how you are and what you like (you could pretend you are running a business and do it for that).
3. One logo redesign, you need to select one of the bad designs from your research and make it better.
4. At least two examples of drawings from life in mediums of your choice. One must be realistic and one can be in your own style.
5. At least two examples of mixed media illustrations, subject of your choice.
6. Any other artwork and/or designs that you feel would support your application. This can be school GCSE work from any year or items you have done at home.
